Voluntary No-Fee Flower Plots Information

Flower border plantings are eye catchers. They also attract beneficial pollinators that enhance our community garden. Once again we are reserving room on the east, west and south sides of the garden for flower border plantings. There are 35 flower plots available at no cost.

If you are assigned a flower garden plot, you must provide the seeds/plants/bulbs. You must also plant, hoe/weed and water the plants. Choose plants which are neither too tall nor block the sunlight to the neighboring vegetable garden. Flower plots are for flowers and are not to be used for vegetables or herbs. If you are interested in a flower plot(s), please indicate your preference on the front of this form (under item 3). Flower plots are numbered the same as adjacent vegetable garden plots, as shown below.

You will automatically be entered in the border flower garden contest. Garden nurseries and stores donate gift certificates as prizes to the border flower garden winners.
