Sun Prairie Plan to Restore the Right to Breathe:

- • **Know Your Rights Workshop, June 10, 4:30 PM**
 - A virtual workshop to understand your rights when interacting with Police in your home, car and community.
- • **No Stupid Questions Quorum, June 23, 6 - 7:30 PM**
 - An ally workshop, dissecting systemic racism and providing space for uncomfortable questions.
- • **Community Self-Policing talk through, Ongoing**
 - Working with communities to understand capacity and opportunities to empower community members in managing their own communities
- • **Juneteenth Celebration, June 15 - 19**
 - A virtual weeklong celebration of Juneteenth in collaboration with community schools. Juneteenth is the celebration of the emancipation proclamation that ended American slavery.
- • **Restorative Dinner, June 25, 6 - 7:30 PM**
 - A dinnertime music show interspersed with community discussion questions to bring the community together around solidarity and action moving forward.
- • **Launch of Equity Academy, Shortly after July 4**
 - An internal continuous training and personal reflection space for city staff that residents will be able to follow along with for their own personal development around equity
