RESOLUTION


WHEREAS, the Committee of the Whole met on January 7, 2020 to discuss increasing the number of alderperson districts in the City of Sun Prairie; and

WHEREAS, after careful review and consideration, the Committee of the Whole recommends the creation of a task force consisting of five citizens and two alderpersons appointed by the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, upon completion of the work of the task force, any change in the number of alderperson districts or the number of alderpersons would be implemented as part of redistricting following the 2020 Census.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City of Sun Prairie, Dane County, Wisconsin, hereby establishes a task force charged with gathering input from city residents and making a recommendation to the Common Council regarding the number of alderperson districts and the number of alderpersons representing each district which the City of Sun Prairie should have in the future to effectively represent the city's growing population.


