What is Sunshine Place?

Sunshine Place is a non-profit that serves as a community resource hub, providing comprehensive services that support essential needs through community engagement and partnerships.

Established in 2007, Sunshine Place has grown to become a single point of access to social services for residents of Sun Prairie and northeastern Dane County. The non-profit houses its own programs and also provides space for partner agencies to co-locate services, providing easy access to help with food, housing, and other support for household and family stability.

What is Sunshine Place's project?

Sunshine Place is looking to upgrade their existing facilities to address rising community needs and challenges with their current three-building campus. Their building and renovation project will replace two buildings with a new building along Main Street and combine their properties into one cohesive, accessible campus.

The total project cost is approximately \$13 million.
