

EXCEPTIONS

This ordinance does not apply to the following:

- Persons on the sidewalk.
- Persons using the safety zone or crosswalk to cross the highway.
- Persons engaged in law enforcement or rescue activities, including providing assistance to an injured or disabled vehicle or person.
- Persons entering a vehicle as an invited passenger where it is lawful to do so, including activity permitted under WI Statute 346.29(1) (Taxis).
- Persons engaged in repair or maintenance activities on the highway under the direction or authority of the City of Sun Prairie or State of WI.
- Streets or portions thereof that have been closed pursuant to a street use permit or other express authorization from the City.

PEDESTRIAN AND DRIVER REGULATIONS

*Ordinance 10.08.090
Pedestrian Regulations*

All covered highways are listed within the ordinance and on the attached map. In addition to the highways highlighted in red, the ordinance covers the first 200 feet of intersecting roads.

Pedestrians must NOT:

- Be on a covered highway or median and approach any vehicle that is not legally parked.
- Stand in the median without crossing the covered highway in a crosswalk or a safety zone.

Drivers must NOT:

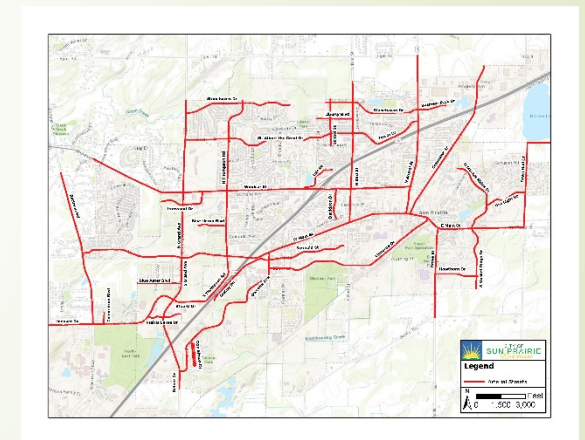
- Park, stop or leave standing your vehicle on a covered highway where it is prohibited.
- Suddenly decrease your vehicle's speed to respond to someone illegally on the covered highway.
- Suddenly deviate from traffic to respond to someone illegally on the covered highway.

Violators of this ordinance may be required to forfeit not less than \$25 and not more than \$300.

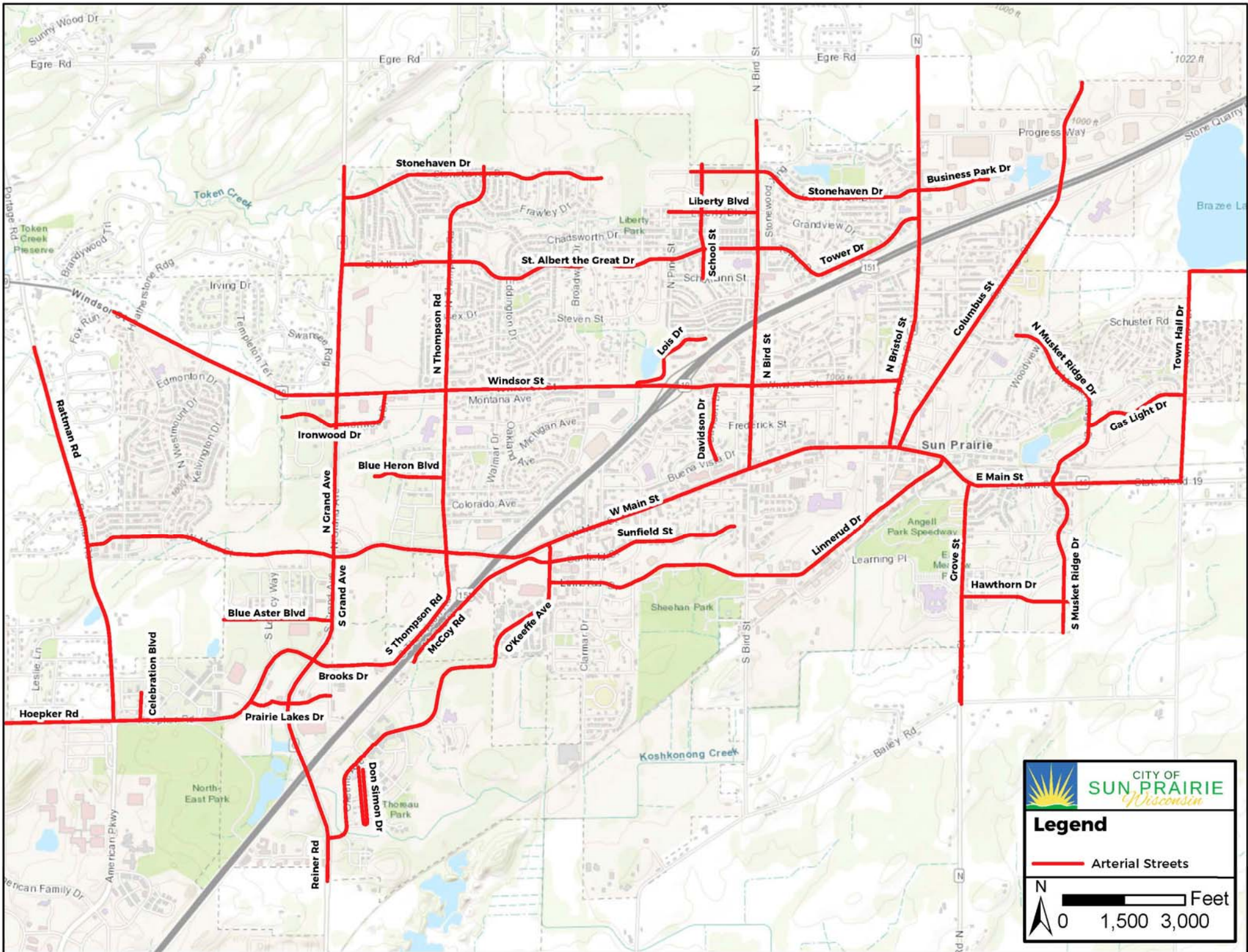
