

**Bill Connors** (District 2, northeast quadrant)

Bill was first elected to the City Council in April 2015 and was re-elected in April 2017. He was chairperson of the Finance Committee in 2016-17 and is the City Council President in 2018-19. Bill has served on the Plan Commission, Finance Committee, Personnel Committee, and Public Works Committee. Bill currently serves as the city government's representative on the Secondary School Space Planning Committee and previously served on the earlier School Space Planning Committee, whose work led to voters' approval of a referendum to build two new elementary schools.

Bill is married to Joan Sorteberg. They have four teenage children. Bill and his family moved to Sun Prairie in 2008.

Bill ran for alderperson because he wants to make Sun Prairie an even greater place to live, raise a family, work, and operate a business. Bill's interests include land use planning, economic development and redevelopment, prudent management of the city's budget and finances, and providing school facilities for the growing number of students in the Sun Prairie Area School District.

Bill has a J.D., M.A. in Public Policy and Administration, and a B.A. in History, all from the University of Wisconsin-Madison. Bill currently sells bedroom furniture and mattresses at Steinhafels on the east side of Madison (part time) and appears in on behalf of creditors in collection matters in small claims courts throughout southern Wisconsin (part time). Bill previously owned and operated a recruiting business. The rest of Bill's career history in reverse chronological order is as follows: Continuing Legal Education director of the State Bar of Wisconsin; city administrator of Evansville, Wisconsin; director of the Tax Increment Financing Division of the Office of the State Auditor; legislative fiscal analyst for the Minnesota House of Representatives; associate attorney with a large law firm in downtown Minneapolis; and judicial law clerk for a U.S. Bankruptcy Judge.
