***Are you, your client, or someone you know sleeping predominantly in emergency shelter, outside, or in a car?***

If so, speaking with a Dane County Coordinated Entry (CE) staff member about available resources may be a good idea!

#### What can Coordinated Entry Staff assist with?

- CE staff perform the VI-SPDAT assessment with eligible clients (i.e. individuals or families who have been sleeping seven days or longer in emergency shelter, outside, or in a car)
- After the assessment, CE staff will add that individual/family to Dane County's Housing Priority List
- Provide information and answer any questions about Dane County's Housing Priority List (i.e. eligibility, the process, programs, etc.)
- CE staff can also assist in highlighting other appropriate homeless services resources in Dane County
